Any surgical or cloth face mask, including a homemade face mask, is acceptable as long as the nose and mouth are fully covered. Candidates without a face mask will be denied testing services. Person Vue does not provide face masks to candidates.</p> <p>Please note: availability is limited at this time due to social distancing guidelines and government guidance. However, some test centers are extending their hours to be open nearly 24 hours a day.
